4. Title: State Board of Elections; Acquisition of DREs.

5. Summary: Allows localities to acquire direct recording electronic machines (DRE's) for the purpose of providing one voting system at each polling place equipped for individuals with disabilities. The local electoral board shall notify the State Board when acquiring DREs under this subdivision and shall certify to the State Board that the DREs acquired under this subdivision are necessary to meet accessible voting requirements.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is no fiscal impact to SBE.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

8. Fiscal Implications: While there is no fiscal impact to SBE, localities are likely to benefit from the enactment of this bill as acquiring DRE's from other localities would cost significantly less than using the current available system.
