**4. Title:**        **Undergrounding of electric transmission lines.**

**5. Summary:** Undergrounding of electric transmission lines. Prohibits the State Corporation Commission from approving an agreement between a local governing body and an electric utility for the underground installation of an electric transmission line of at least 150 kilovolts if a practicably feasible overhead alternative exists, unless all localities in which the underground segment of the line passes request that the line be installed underground.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No fiscal impact on state agencies; however, there is potential fiscal impact on localities. See Item 8.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Localities requesting the State Corporation Commission to approve an agreement with the utility to have a new transmission line constructed underground when there is a feasible overhead alternative, must create special tax districts to impose and collect local tax revenue to cover the incremental costs of the underground construction.
