4. Title: **Health insurance; coverage for mental health and substance abuse services**

5. Summary: Removes the benefit limitations applicable to coverage for inpatient, partial hospitalization, and outpatient mental health and substance abuse services under large group health insurance policies. Under this measure, coverage for such services under large group policies will not be more restrictive than for other illness. The existing limitations will continue to apply to individual and small group policies.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Human Resource Management indicates that this bill should not create a fiscal impact to the health insurance programs managed by the agency because these programs are already in compliance with the provisions of the bill.
