CHAPTER 112

An Act to amend and reenact § 19.2-130.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to bail terms set by court on a capias; when honored by magistrate.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 19.2-130.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 19.2-130.1. Bail terms set by court on a capias to be honored by magistrate.

A magistrate who is to set the terms of bail of a person arrested and brought before him pursuant to § 19.2-234 shall ~~do so~~, *unless circumstances exist that require him to set more restrictive terms, set the terms of bail* in accordance with the order of the court that issued the capias, if such an order is affixed to or made a part of the capias by the court.
