9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 24.2-700.1 as follows:
12	§ 24.2-700.1. Early voting.
13 14	A. Any registered voter may vote early, in accordance with the provisions of this section, in any
14	general, primary, or special election in which he is qualified to vote. B. Early voting shall begin on the fourteenth day before an election and end at 5:00 p.m. on the
16	Saturday immediately preceding the election. Early voting shall be provided during regular office hours
17	each weekday during the applicable period, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on each Saturday during the
18	applicable period, and until 8:00 p.m. on the Monday eight days before the election and the immediately
19	following Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Early voting shall begin on the eighth day before a
20	special election held on a date other than a general election day and end at 5:00 p.m. on the Saturday
21	immediately preceding the election. Notice of the times for early voting shall be given in accordance
22 23	with the instructions of the State Board. C. Each electoral board shall provide for early voting in the office of the general registrar or
23 24	secretary of the electoral board. The State Board shall prescribe procedures for the use of voting
25	equipment that has been certified, and is currently approved, by the State Board. The procedures shall
26	be applicable and uniformly applied by the State Board to all jurisdictions using comparable voting
27	equipment.
28	D. Each registered voter shall comply with the identification requirements applicable to voting at the
29	polls on election day.
30	E. The provisions of this chapter for in person absentee voting shall not be applicable during the
31	period for early voting, and early voting procedures shall be deemed to supersede and replace absentee
32 33	voting procedures during the early voting period. F. The State Board shall provide instructions for the preparation, maintenance, and reporting of
33 34	ballots, pollbooks, records, and returns for early voting.
35	2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 2012.
