| 10 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 11 | 1. That § 2.2-2329 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 12 | § 2.2-2329. Board of directors; members and officers; executive director. |
| 13 | A. The Authority shall be governed by a board of directors consisting of 18 19 nonlegislative |
| 14 | members appointed as follows: four members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; |
| 15 | two members to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; and 12 13 members to be appointed |
| 16 | by the Governor as follows: (i) three persons who are retired General Officers or Department of Defense |
| 17 | Senior Executive Service members representing the United States Armed Forces or the Department of |
| 18 | Defense, (ii) four persons representing civic interests in the regions of Central Virginia, Southwestern |
| 19 | Virginia, Northern Virginia, and Hampton Roads, (iii) one person representing higher education, (iv) two |
| 20 | persons with experience in commercial real estate and public financing, (v) the Adjutant General of |
| 21 | Virginia, and (vi) the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, and (vii) an Assistant to the Governor or other |
| 22 | member of the Governor's Cabinet. |
| 23 | B. With the exception of initial staggered terms and the appointment of the Adjutant General of |
| 24 | Virginia, and the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, and the Assistant to the Governor or other member |
| 25 | of the Governor's Cabinet, who shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office, all appointments |
| 26 | shall be for six years. Any appointment to fill a vacancy on the Board shall be made for the unexpired |
| 27 | term of the member whose death, resignation or removal created the vacancy. |
| 28 | C. The Board shall annually elect one of its members as chairman and another as vice-chairman. The |
| 29 | chairman or, in his absence, the vice-chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Board. Meetings of |
| 30 | the Board shall be held at the call of the chairman or of any seven members. Nine Ten members shall |
| 31 | constitute a quorum for the transaction of the Authority's business, and no vacancy in the membership |
| 32 | shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all the duties of the Authority. |
| 33 | D. The members of the Board shall be entitled to reimbursement for their reasonable travel, meal, |
| 34 | and lodging expenses incurred in attending the meetings of the Board or while otherwise engaged in the |
| 35 | discharge of their duties. Such expenses shall be paid out of the treasury of the Authority upon vouchers |
| 36 | signed by the chairman of the Board or by such other person designated by the Board for this purpose. |

40 shall be compensated in the manner provided by the Board and shall not be subject to the provisions of
41 the Virginia Personnel Act (§ 2.2-2900 et seq.).
