That § 18.2-308.1:4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 18.2-308.1:4. Purchase or transportation of firearm by persons subject to protective orders; penalty. 11 It shall be unlawful for any person who is subject to (i) a protective order entered pursuant to 12 §§ 16.1-253, 16.1-253.1, 16.1-253.4, 16.1-279.1, 19.2-152.8, 19.2-152.9, or § 19.2-152.10; (ii) an order 13 issued pursuant to subsection B of § 20-103; (iii) an order entered [on or after July 1, 2011,] pursuant 14 15 to subsection D of § 18.2-60.3; or (iv) a preliminary protective order entered pursuant to $\begin{bmatrix} \frac{1}{2} & \frac{1}{2} & \frac{1}{2} & \frac{1}{2} \end{bmatrix}$ containing a finding of abuse subsection \vec{F} of § 16.1-253 where a petition alleging abuse or neglect has 16 been filed]; or (v) an order issued by a tribunal of another state, the United States or any of its 17 territories, possessions or commonwealths, or the District of Columbia pursuant to a statute that is 18 19 substantially similar to those cited in clauses (i), (ii), or (iii) to purchase or transport any firearm while 20 the order is in effect. Any person with a concealed handgun permit shall be prohibited from carrying 21 any concealed firearm, and shall surrender his permit to the court entering the order, for the duration of 22 any protective order referred to herein. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
