11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-873.01 as follows:
12	§ 46.2-873.01. Designation, marking, enforcement of school zones in unincorporated planned
13	residential communities.
14	The civic association, homeowners association, or other elected body of any unincorporated planned
15	residential community may designate and mark school zones on public highways within the
16	unincorporated planned residential community's boundaries. Markings, signs, speed limits, and other
17	requirements and limitations otherwise applicable to school zones under § 46.2-873 shall apply, mutatis
18	mutandis, to school zones designated and marked as provided in this section. The cost of the designation
19	and marking of any such school zones shall be borne entirely by the unincorporated planned residential
20	and manning of any such school could shall be some chinery by the united pointed plained residential
