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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 30-172 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 30-172. Powers and duties of Commission.
13	The Commission shall have the power and duty to:
14	1. Encourage and arrange conferences with officials of other states and other units of government;
15	2. Carry forward the participation of Virginia as a member of the Council of State Governments,
16	both regionally and nationally;
17	3. Formulate proposals for cooperation between Virginia and other states;
18	4.3. Establish such committees as it deems advisable to conduct conferences and formulate proposals
19	concerning subjects of interstate cooperation;
20	5. 4. Monitor and evaluate the Commonwealth's participation in interstate compacts;
21	6. 5. Review, evaluate, and recommend suggested uniform state legislation;
22 23	7. 6. Require, at its discretion, from any appointee representing Virginia on any interstate compact,
23 24	commission, committee, or board, a report on that organization's work and accomplishments; 8.7. Review, evaluate, and make recommendations concerning federal policies that are of concern to
