6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 4.1-1, as amended, of Chapter 52 of the Acts of Assembly of 1958 is amended and**
8 **reenacted as follows:**

9 § 4.1-1. Board of Architectural Review.

10 The council may appoint a Board of Architectural Review consisting of five members, at least four
11 of whom shall be residents of the town and representative of the following professions or interests:
12 architecture, landscape architecture, urban or town planning, historic preservation, and a citizen
13 representative. *However, the council may, in its discretion, appoint up to 7 members. Such additional*
14 *members need not be residents of the town.*

15 The terms of office of the members of the board shall be four years with terms being staggered
16 initially such that one member shall be appointed for a term of one year, a second member appointed
17 for a term of two years, a third member appointed for a term of three years and the remaining two
18 members appointed for terms of four years. The terms of the members shall take effect on July 1, 2004.

19 The Board of Architectural Review shall be responsible for the review and implementation of
20 architectural design standards for all commercial and overlay districts as approved by the town council.
21 The application of the standards shall apply to new construction, exterior renovations, parking areas,
22 signage, streetscapes, street and street intersection design and pedestrian ways.
