6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 19.2-136 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 19.2-136. How bonds in recognizances payable; penalty.

9 Bonds in recognizances in criminal or juvenile cases, where the violation is committed against the 10 Commonwealth or where the Commonwealth is a party, shall be payable to the Commonwealth of

11 Virginia. Bonds in recognizances in criminal cases where the violation is a violation of a county, city or

12 town ordinance, shall be payable to such the county, city or town wherein the recognizance was taken.

13 The Treasurer or Director of Finance of such county, city or town may engage in collection activity

14 regarding the judgment of default rendered pursuant to § 19.2-143. Any responses to the judgment of

15 default rendered pursuant to § 19.2-143 shall be filed with the court, with notice given to the county,

16 city or town wherein the recognizance was taken. Every bond under this title shall be in such sum as

17 the court or officer requiring it may direct.
