That § 33.1-221.1:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 33.1-221.1:1. Fund for construction of industrial access railroad tracks. 12 13 A. The General Assembly declares it to be in the public interest that access railroad tracks and 14 facilities be constructed to certain industrial commercial sites where rail freight service is or may be 15 needed by new or substantially expanded industry and that financial assistance be provided to areas 16 seeking to furnish rail freight trackage between the normal limits of existing or proposed common carrier railroad tracks and facilities and the actual site of existing or proposed commercial or industrial 17 18 buildings or facilities. This section is enacted in furtherance of these purposes and is intended to be 19 comparable to the Industrial Access Roads Fund, established pursuant to § 33.1-221. 20 **B**. The funding for this program shall be set forth in the Appropriations Act. 21 C. The Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation shall administer and expend or commit, subject to the approval of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, such funds for 22 23 constructing, reconstructing, or improving industrial access railroad tracks and related facilities. The 24 Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation may consult with the Commissioner of 25 Agriculture and Consumer Services and the Chief Executive Officer of the Virginia Economic Development Partnership, or their designated representatives, concerning applications for funds. Funds 26 27 shall be spent directly by the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation or by 28 reimbursement of the local entities, private or public. 29 D. Funds may be used to construct, reconstruct, or improve part or all of the necessary tracks and 30 related facilities on public or private property currently used or being developed, existent or prospective, 31 for single industries or industrial subdivisions under firm contract or already constructed, including those 32 subdivisions owned or promoted by railroad companies and others. Applications for funds must be 33 approved by the local governing body. 34 E. In deciding whether to construct any such access track, the Commonwealth Transportation Board 35 shall consider the cost thereof in relation to prospective volume of rail traffic, capital investment, 36 potential employment, and other economic and public benefits. The Commonwealth Transportation 37 Board shall adopt procedures to encourage widespread use of the funds, shall limit allocation of funds so 38 that no county, city or town receives more than twenty-five percent a disproportionate share of the 39 funds in any one fiscal year unless there are not sufficient applications prior to May 1 of each year to 40 use the available funds, and shall consider the practices of the Department of Transportation in 41 distributing industrial access road funds under § 33.1-221. F. Tracks and facilities constructed with such funds shall be the property of the Commonwealth for 42 the useful life of the project as determined by the Director of the Department of Rail and Public 43 Transportation and shall be made available for use by all common carriers using the railway system to 44 45 which they connect. The landowners or using businesses shall, prior to the commitment of funds by the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation, be contractually committed to the 46

perpetual maintenance of such tracks and facilities so constructed and to the payment of any costs

related to the future relocation or removal of such tracks and facilities.

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
