5	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
6	1. That § 15.2-1613.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
7	§ 15.2-1613.1. Processing fee may be imposed on certain individuals.
8	Any county or city may by ordinance authorize a processing fee not to exceed \$25 on any individual
9	admitted to a county, city, or regional jail following conviction. The fee shall be ordered as a part of
10	court costs collected by the clerk, deposited into the account of the treasurer of the county or city and
11	shall be used by the local sheriff's office to defray the costs of processing arrested persons into local or
12	regional jails. If processing costs are incurred by a regional jail rather than a local sheriff's office, the
13	fees collected pursuant to such ordinance may be used by the regional jail to defray the costs of
14	processing arrested persons. Where costs are incurred by a sheriff's office and a regional jail the fees
15	collected pursuant to such ordinance may be divided proportionately as determined by the local
16	governing body or bodies, between the sheriff's office and the regional jail. Where costs are incurred by
17	a police department for booking or fingerprinting services, the fees collected pursuant to such ordinance
18	may be divided proportionately as determined by the local governing body or bodies, between the
19	sheriff's office and the police department.
