10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-743. Special license plates for members of the Virginia State Defense Force and certain
13	veterans; fees.
14	A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
15	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
16	applicant special license plates.
17	B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
18	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
19	United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
20	design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of
21	persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
22	plates under this subsection.
23	C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
24	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
25	United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
26	incorporates an emblem of the United States Army.
27	C1. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
28	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
29	United States Navy, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
30	incorporates an emblem of the United States Navy.
31	D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
32	the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license
33 24	plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of
34 35	state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued. E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
35 36	War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.
37	F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
38	War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.
39	G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the
4 0	Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that
41	campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in
42	addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are
43	issued.
44	H. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation Iraqi
45	Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
46	I. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
47	Enduring Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation
48	Enduring Freedom.
49	J. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Virginia
50	State Defense Force, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the Virginia
51	State Defense Force.
52	K. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued
53	under subsection A, D, E, F, H, I, or J of this section.
