10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 19.2-353.5 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 19.2-353.5. Interest on fines and costs.
13	No interest shall accrue on any fine or costs imposed in a criminal case or in a case involving a
14	traffic infraction for a period of forty 40 days from the date of the final judgment imposing such fine or
15	costs or during any period the defendant is incarcerated as a result of that case. Interest on fines and
16	costs imposed by other such judgments that have accrued for any period the defendant was incarcerated
17	shall be purged upon submission of an affidavit to the court or the collection agency providing
18	documentation of such incarceration using a form prepared by the Office of the Executive Secretary of
19	the Supreme Court. In no event shall interest accrue in such cases during any period in which a fine,
20	costs, or both a fine and costs are being paid in deferred or installment payments pursuant to an order of
21	the court. Whenever interest on any unpaid fine or costs accrues, it shall accrue at the judgment rate of
22	interest set forth in § 6.1-330.54 6.2-302.
