11100380D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 512** 1 2 House Amendments in [] - January 21, 2011 3 Designating November, in 2011 and in each succeeding year, as Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month in 4 Virginia. 5 Patron Prior to Engrossment-Delegate Loupassi 6 7 Referred to Committee on Rules 8 9 WHEREAS, the good health and well-being of the residents of the Commonwealth are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about pancreatic cancer and research into early detection, causes, 10 and effective treatments: and 11 WHEREAS, in 2010 an estimated 42,000 people were diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in the United 12 13 States and an estimated 36,800 died from the disease, including approximately 930 in Virginia; and WHEREAS, pancreatic cancer is one of the deadliest cancers and is the fourth leading cause of 14 15 cancer death in the United States; and WHEREAS, symptoms of pancreatic cancer can include pain, weight loss, jaundice, loss of appetite, 16 17 nausea, and diabetes; and WHEREAS, when symptoms of pancreatic cancer present themselves, it is usually too late for an 18 optimistic prognosis, and 75 percent of pancreatic cancer patients die within the first year of their diagnosis while 94 percent of pancreatic cancer patients die within the first five years; and 19 20 WHEREAS, incidence of pancreatic cancer is approximately 50 percent higher in African Americans 21 than in other ethnic groups; and 22 WHEREAS, there is no cure for pancreatic cancer and there have been no significant improvements 23 24 in survival rates in the last 40 years; and 25 WHEREAS, the number of new pancreatic cancer cases is expected to increase by 55 percent between 2010 and 2030; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network and its affiliates in the Commonwealth support 28 those patients currently battling cancer, as well as the families of those who have lost their lives to the 29 disease and are committed to nothing less than a cure; now, therefore, be it 30 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate 31 November, in 2011 and in each succeeding year, as Pancreatic Cancer Awareness Month in Virginia; 32 and, be it 33 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the General Assembly encourage all Virginians to increase their 34 awareness of the symptoms of pancreatic cancer and join with the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network 35 and its affiliates in the Commonwealth to support those patients battling the disease as well as programs 36

of research and education; and [, be it]
