WHEREAS, admired for his enthusiastic and innovative spirit, Mayor Tull worked tirelessly over the years on behalf of the town's 350 residents; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his mayoral duties, Charles Tull generously gave of his time and talents in the community as a member of the Temperanceville Lodge #121 and Saxis Volunteer Fire Company; and

WHEREAS, a devoted family man, Charles Tull will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his loving wife, Teresa; children, Jennifer and Barbea, and their families; his mother, Beatrice; and numerous other family members, friends, and the citizens of Saxis; now, therefore, be it
