13	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
15	Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article IV a section numbered 16-A as follows:
16	ARTICLE IV
17	LEGISLATURE
18	Section 16-A. Repeal of state law or regulation by localities.
19	Any provision of state law or state regulation may be repealed by the several counties and cities as
20	provided in this section. Such repeal shall be effective when the governing bodies of the several counties
21	and cities containing at least two-thirds of the population of Virginia, as shown by the most recent
22	United States decennial census, approve resolutions for this purpose within a twenty-four month period,
23	and the resolutions particularly describe the same provision or provisions of law or regulation to be
24	repealed.
