5 6 WHEREAS, Marian A. White is commended on the occasion of her retirement as Executive 7 Assistant to the County Administrator and Deputy Clerk to the Board of Supervisors of King William 8 County; and

9 WHEREAS, born on June 20, 1944, to Vollie and Annie Edwards Allen, Marian White was raised in 10 the Whites Shop area and graduated from King William High School in 1962; and

WHEREAS, a long-time member of Colosse Baptist Church in King William, Marian White and her 11 12 husband, Herbert, had one son, Scott; and

WHEREAS, Marian White began a career that would span more than three decades with King 13 14 William County on December 9, 1974, as a secretary and dispatcher for the Sheriff's Office; and

15 WHEREAS, on January 1, 1977, Marian White transferred to the County Administrator's Office to assume the role of Executive Assistant to the County Administrator and Deputy Clerk to the Board of 16 17 Supervisors: and

WHEREAS, during her tenure with the County Administrator's Office, Marian White worked with 18 18 19 different members of the Board of Supervisors and six county administrators; and

20 WHEREAS, Marian White witnessed sweeping changes in the land use policies of King William 21 County, including the adoption and implementation of the first county zoning ordinance, effective July 1, 1977, and the first subdivision ordinance, effective January 24, 1979; and 22

WHEREAS, present for the growth and development of King William County government, Marian 23 24 White saw the renovation of the historic courthouse and the Circuit Court Clerk's Office; and

25 WHEREAS, Marian White witnessed the construction of numerous public buildings including the Administration Building, the L.T. McAllister Human Services Building, the Courts and Public Safety 26 27 Building, and the Regional Animal Shelter; and

28 WHEREAS, dedicated to her native county, Marian White devoted her energies to improving the 29 safety and services available to her community as a founder and past president of the King William 30 Volunteer Fire Department and Rescue Squad Auxiliary and the Mattaponi Volunteer Rescue Squad 31 Auxiliary; she was a Charter Member and officer of Mattaponi Crime Solvers, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, an avid history buff, Marian White witnessed the commissioning of the County 32 33 Coat-of-Arms through the College of Arms in London, served as secretary to the King William County Tricentennial Committee, and is an active member of the King William County Historical Society; and 34

35 WHEREAS, Marian White has lent her immeasurable support to the endeavors of King William County and has committed her charismatic career to ensuring a prosperous and secure future for the 36 37 residents, businesses, and schools of King William County; now, therefore, be it

38 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly 39 commend Marian A. White on the occasion of her retirement as Executive Assistant to the County Administrator and Deputy Clerk to the Board of Supervisors of King William County; and, be it 40
