HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 756

Commending Tommy Woodson.

WHEREAS, Tommy Woodson was honored to be recognized as the Virginia Independent Automobile Dealers Association Quality Dealer of the Year for 2006; and

WHEREAS, Tommy Woodson has also rendered valuable service to the Commonwealth through his service as a member of the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the coveted statewide award, Tommy Woodson was chosen as the District Quality Dealer and had the opportunity to represent the Commonwealth at the national convention in Nashville, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Tommy Woodson's excellent business acumen and dedication to the automobile industry, his community, and the Virginia Independent Automobile Dealers Association make him an outstanding recipient of this prestigious award; now, therefore, be it
