WHEREAS, committed to the Masonic ideals and principles, Braxton Parks joined the Central Lodge 18 19 300 Ancient Free and Accepted Masons and was a former member of Parksley Lodge 325 Ancient Free 20 and Accepted Masons; he received his 50-year pin, was a member of Khedive Shrine Temple, and 21 achieved 32nd degree in the Scottish Rite Bodies; and

22 WHEREAS, Braxton Parks was the oldest living member of Grace United Methodist Church in 23 Parksley, where he held many administrative and committee positions and was a member of the 24 Methodist Men; and
