13 14	A. Beginning July 6, 2008, for claims effective on or after July 6, 2008, but before July 3 1, 2011
14	2012, an eligible individual's weekly "benefit amount" shall be the amount appearing in Column B in the "Benefit Table" in this section on the line on which in Column A of such table, there appears the
16	total wages for insured work paid to such individual in the two quarters of his base period in which
17 18	such total wages were highest. SEE PRINTED BILL FOR TABLES
10 19	B. Beginning July 3 1, 2011 2012, for claims effective on or after July 3 1, 2011 2012, an eligible
20	individual's weekly "benefit amount" shall be the amount appearing in Column B in the "Benefit Table"
21	in this section on the line on which in Column A of such table, there appears the total wages for insured
22	work paid to such individual in the two quarters of his base period in which such total wages were
23	highest.
