10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 46.2-865.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 46.2-865.1. Injuring another or causing the death of another while engaging in a race; penalties.
13	A. Any person who, while engaging in a race in violation of § 46.2-865 in a manner so gross,
14	wanton and culpable as to show a reckless disregard for human life:
15	1. Causes serious bodily injury to another person who is not involved in the violation of § 46.2-865
16	is guilty of a Class 6 felony; or
17	2. Causes the death of another person is guilty of a felony punishable by a term of imprisonment of
18	not less than one nor more than 20 years, one year of which shall be a mandatory minimum term of
19	imprisonment of 20 years.
20	B. Upon conviction, the court shall suspend the driver's license of such person for a period of not
21	less than one year nor more than three years, and shall order the surrender of the license to be disposed
22	of in accordance with the provisions of § 46.2-398.
23	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}$
24	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is
25 26	\$47,273 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be determined
26	for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
