10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 24.2-518 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 24.2-518. County and city treasurers to pay primary expenses; reimbursement by state; certain uses
13	of machinery by party.
14	The treasurer of the county or city in which the elections are held shall pay the costs of primary
15	elections. Each county and city shall be reimbursed for the costs of primary elections for statewide and
16	federal offices as provided in the general appropriation act.
17	A political party may hold an election to select the members of its party committee at the same time
18	and in the same places as a primary election without fee or charge for making use of the electoral
19 20	machinery, provided that a primary to nominate the party's candidate for an office is in fact conducted
20	on that primary date. Such elections for party committee members may be conducted by paper ballots or
21	by voting machines in the discretion of the local electoral board.
22 23	The proper political party committee shall pay the costs of using the election machinery at any other time for the purpose of conducting other pomineting procedures adopted purpose to the rules of that
23 24	time for the purpose of conducting other nominating procedures adopted pursuant to the rules of that
24	party, if such use is authorized by the officials having custody of the machinery.
