6.1 (§ 51.1-607 et seq.), or 7 (§ 51.1-700 et seq.), his retirement allowance shall cease while so employed. Any member who retires and later returns to covered employment shall not be entitled to select a different retirement option for a subsequent retirement.

64 2. Active members of the General Assembly who are eligible to receive a retirement allowance under 65 this title, excluding their service as a member of the General Assembly, shall be eligible to receive a retirement allowance based on their creditable service and average final compensation for service other 66 than as a member of the General Assembly. Such members of the General Assembly shall continue to 67 be reported as any other members of the retirement system. Upon ceasing to serve in the General **68** Assembly, members of the General Assembly receiving a retirement allowance based on their creditable 69 70 service and average final compensation for service other than as a member of the General Assembly 71 shall have their retirement allowance recomputed prospectively to include their service as a member of the General Assembly. Active members of the General Assembly shall be prohibited from receiving a 72 73 service retirement allowance under this title based solely on their service as a member of the General 74 Assembly.

75 3. (Expires July 1, 2015) Any person receiving a service retirement allowance under this chapter,
76 who is hired as a local school board instructional or administrative employee required to be licensed by
77 the Board of Education, may elect to continue to receive the retirement allowance during such
78 employment, under the following conditions:

79 (a) The person has been receiving such retirement allowance for a certain period of time preceding80 his employment as provided by law;

(b) The person is not receiving a retirement benefit pursuant to an early retirement incentive programfrom any local school division within the Commonwealth; and

(c) At the time the person is employed, the position to which he is assigned is among those
identified by the Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to subdivision 4 of § 22.1-23, by the
relevant division superintendent, pursuant to § 22.1-70.3, or by the relevant local school board, pursuant
to subdivision 9 of § 22.1-79.

87 If the person elects to continue to receive the retirement allowance during the period of such employment, then his service performed and compensation received during such period of time will not increase, decrease, or affect in any way his retirement benefits before, during, or after such employment.

4. Any person receiving a service retirement allowance pursuant to the benefits permitted under
§ 51.1-138, Chapter 2 (§ 51.1-200 et seq.), or Chapter 2.1 (§ 51.1-211 et seq.) who is hired as a local
school board security officer or security personnel may elect to continue to receive the retirement
allowance during such employment, under the following conditions:

a. The person has attained age 50 and the person's effective date of retirement is at least one full
calendar year (or such longer period of time as adopted by the Board in its policies and procedures)
prior to the person commencing employment as a local school board security officer or security
personnel;

98 b. The person is not receiving a retirement benefit pursuant to an early retirement incentive program
99 from any "employer" as defined in § 51.1-124.3;

100 c. The person did not participate in any incentive program established under the second or third 101 enactment of Chapters 152 and 811 of the Acts of Assembly of 1995; and

d. The hiring school division agrees to and shall pay to the Virginia Retirement System, during such
 person's employment as a local school board security officer or security personnel, the employer share
 of the retirement funding contribution that would otherwise be due if the person were a covered
 employee.

106 If the person elects to continue to receive the retirement allowance during the period of such
107 employment, then his service performed and compensation received during such period of time will not
108 increase, decrease, or affect in any way his retirement benefits before, during, or after such employment.

2. That the Board of the Virginia Retirement System and the Joint Legislative Audit and Review 109 Commission shall jointly determine the period of time preceding employment, required pursuant 110 to subdivision B 4 a of § 51.1-155 of the Code of Virginia, that (i) will result in there being no 111 negative fiscal impact to the Commonwealth pursuant to the provisions of this act and (ii) shall be 112 113 consistent with the federal tax qualification of the relevant retirement plans administered by the Virginia Retirement System. Such determination shall be made in consultation with the actuary of 114 the Virginia Retirement System, the actuary of the Joint Legislative Audit and Review 115 Commission, and the Chairmen of the Senate Committee on Finance and the House Committee on 116 Appropriations. The Board shall adopt such jointly determined period of time, and no other, for 117 purposes of providing for the persons described in subdivision B 4 of § 51.1-155 of the Code of 118 119 Virginia to continue to receive their retirement allowances while employed as provided in such subdivision. Only if such persons have been retired for such jointly determined period of time 120

121 shall such persons be permitted to elect to continue to receive their retirement allowances while 122 employed as provided in such subdivision, unless the general appropriation act in effect at the 123 relevant time provides a required period of retirement that is less than such jointly determined 124 period of time. The Board of the Virginia Retirement System shall promulgate all reasonable and 125 necessary policies and procedures to carry out the provisions of this act.
