12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 8 of Chapter 1 of Title 9.1 a section
13	numbered 9.1-172.1 as follows:
14	§ 9.1-172.1. Reimbursement for law-enforcement training by certain public employers.
15	
	A. As used in this section, "public employer" means the Commonwealth or any locality.
16	B. Whenever a public employer provides law-enforcement training for a person who has been or will
17	be hired as a law-enforcement officer with such employer, and such person terminates his position with
18	the employer to work as a law-enforcement officer within two years of completing the training, the

19 subsequent employer shall reimburse the former employer the reasonable costs incurred for the training.
