10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 17.1-906 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 17.1-906. Jurisdiction of Supreme Court.
13	In addition to the jurisdiction conferred on the Supreme Court by Article VI, Section 1 and Section
14	10 of the Constitution of Virginia, to conduct evidentiary hearings and impose sanctions upon the filing
15	by the Commission of complaints against justices of the Supreme Court, judges of other courts of
16	record, and members of the State Corporation Commission, the Supreme Court by virtue of this chapter
17	shall have the same jurisdiction, to be exercised in the same manner, upon the filing by the Commission
18	of complaints against all other judges as defined in this chapter. Both the Commission and the judge
19	shall be entitled to present evidence and argument during such hearings. The Court may enter any
20	scheduling orders it deems necessary.
