A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-875 of the Code of Virginia, relating to maximum speed limits on certain highways; increase of speed limits by certain municipalities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-875 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-875. Maximum speed limit on certain other highways in cities and towns.

The maximum speed limit shall be ~~thirty-five~~ 35 miles per hour on highways in any city or town, except on interstate or other limited access highways with divided roadways and in business or residence districts. *However, municipalities that maintain their own roads may increase speed limits to no greater than 45 miles per hour on four-lane divided highways with proper design speed following appropriate traffic engineering investigation.*
