That § 18.2-461 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 18.2-461. Falsely summoning or giving false reports to law-enforcement officials. 12 13 It shall be unlawful for any person (i) to knowingly give a false report as to the commission of any crime to any law-enforcement official with intent to mislead, or (ii) without just cause and with intent to 14 15 interfere with the operations of any law-enforcement official, to call or summon any law-enforcement 16

official by telephone or other means, including engagement or activation of an automatic emergency alarm. Violation of the provisions of this section shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor 6 felony.

2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$2,896,708 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$95,282 for

periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
