| 9 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 1 of Title 65.2 a section numbered |
| 10 | 65.2-105 as follows: |
| 11 | § 65.2-105. Presumption that certain injuries are work related. |
| 12 | In any claim for compensation, where the employee is physically or mentally unable to testify as |
| 13 | confirmed by competent medical evidence and where there is unrebutted prima facie evidence that |
| 14 | indicates that the injury was work related, it shall be presumed, in the absence of a preponderance of |
| 15 | evidence to the contrary, that the injury was work related. |
