Senate Amendments in [] — January 19, 2011

A BILL to amend and reenact § 8.01-628 of the Code of Virginia, relating to temporary injunctions.

Patron Prior to Engrossment—Senator Petersen

Referred to Committee for Courts of Justice

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 8.01-628 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 8.01-628. Considerations in awarding temporary injunctions.

No temporary injunction shall be awarded unless the court shall be satisfied of the plaintiff's equity. In assessing whether to award a temporary injunction, a court shall [determine the prevailing party and fashion relief based upon review] the following factors: (i) the likelihood of irreparable harm to the party seeking the temporary injunction if the temporary injunction is denied; (ii) the likelihood of harm to the party not seeking the temporary injunction if the temporary injunction is granted; (iii) the likelihood that the party seeking the temporary injunction will succeed on the merits; and (iv) the public interest.
