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1	SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 137
2	Offered January 22, 2010
3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 7-B,
4	relating to funds for transportation purposes.
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7	Referred to Committee on Privileges and Elections
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9	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, a majority of the members elected to
10	each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same
11	hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next
12	general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the
13	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
14	Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article X a section numbered 7-B as follows:
15	ARTICLE X
16	TAXATION AND FINANCE
17	Section 7-B. Funds for transportation.
18	(a) The General Assembly shall maintain permanent and separate Transportation Funds. The
19 20	Commonwealth Transportation Fund, Transportation Trust Fund, Highway Maintenance and Operating
20 21	Fund, Priority Transportation Fund, any other fund established by general law for transportation, and all subsidiary accounts and parts thereof, shall be deemed Transportation Funds for purposes of this

$\frac{22}{23}$	(b) There shall be deposited to the Transportation Funds all revenues dedicated to the
23 24	Transportation Funds under provisions of general law, but excluding a general appropriation law, in
25	effect on January 1, 2011. However, the General Assembly may by general law, but excluding a general
26	appropriation law, make changes to the revenues dedicated and paid to the Transportation Funds.
27	Monies in the Transportation Funds may be invested as authorized by law.
28	(c) All monies deposited to the Transportation Funds shall be appropriated only for purposes of
29	financing, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining, and operating transportation systems and
30	projects in the Commonwealth.
31	(d) The General Assembly may borrow from Transportation Funds for other purposes only by a vote
32	equal to or greater than two-thirds plus one of the members voting in each house, including a majority
33	of the members elected to that house. The name of each member voting and how he voted shall be
34	recorded in the journal of each house. Any amount borrowed shall be repaid to the Transportation
35	Funds, with reasonable interest, not later than the end of the third full fiscal year following the effective
36	date of the borrowing.
37	(e) Monies designated for deposit to funds other than Transportation Funds shall not be used for any
38 39	transportation-related purpose except for (i) making debt service payments on any transportation-related bands or other obligations issued purpose to Article Y. Section $Q_{i}(z)$ of this Constitution in these eases
39 40	bonds or other obligations issued pursuant to Article X, Section 9 (c) of this Constitution in those cases in which the revenues dedicated for the payment of the debt service on such bonds or other obligations
40 41	are insufficient to make full payment or (ii) making debt service payments on Commonwealth of Virginia
42	Federal Highway Reimbursement Anticipation Notes issued on or before January 1, 2011.
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
