WHEREAS, in 1996, Adlena Coleman returned to Virginia to be near her daughter and began to worship at Mount Zion AME Church; and

WHEREAS, loved by her friends and family for her sweet nature and giving heart, Adlena Coleman took great pleasure in spending time with her beloved family; and

WHERÊAS, Adlena Coleman will be greatly missed by her son, Bruce, and his family, including precious grandchildren, Wendell and Bruce, and great-grandsons, Liam and Ross; now, therefore, be it
