10	WHEREAS, eating disorders include anorexia, bulimia, binge eating disorder, and eating disorder not
11	otherwise specified; and
12	WHEREAS, eating disorders affect approximately 11 million Americans and affect people from all
13	backgrounds, regardless of race, ethnicity, age, gender, and socioeconomic status; and
14	WHEREAS, eating disorders are becoming more prevalent at younger ages, including in children as
15	young as seven years old; and
16	WHEREAS, eating disorders have been stigmatized and not treated as the serious, sometimes fatal,
17 18	illnesses they are; and WHEREAS, eating disorders affect every system of the body and are associated with serious medical
10 19	complications including cardiac arrhythmia, cognitive impairment, osteoporosis, infertility, heart failure,
20	and death; and
$\overline{21}$	WHEREAS, eating disorders have the highest mortality rate, upwards of 20 percent, of any mental
22	illness; and
23	WHEREAS, eating disorders are treatable with appropriate referrals and fair coverage for treatment;
24	less than half of all people with eating disorders receive the treatment they both need and deserve; and
25	WHEREAS, eating disorders research is grossly underfunded, thus stalling program development and
26	the general public's knowledge of eating disorders; and
27 28	WHEREAS, education of eating disorders, to health care professionals and the general public, is lacking; eating disorders are all too often undiagnosed or misdiagnosed by health professionals; and
20 29	WHEREAS, in 2011, National Eating Disorder Awareness Week will be observed during the last full
3 0	week of February, the 20th through the 26th; now, therefore, be it
31	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly designate
32	the last full week in February, in 2011 and in each succeeding year, as Eating Disorder Awareness
33	Week in Virginia; and, be it
34	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate post the designation of this week on the
