Ellis 15 Gymnasium during the 2009-2010 season; and WHEREAS, Head Coach Mazé Toomer was named District, Region, and State Division I Coach of 16 the Year by his peers: and 17 WHEREAS, players Britney Johnson and RaeChaun Edwards were selected to the All-District First 18 19 Team and Whitney Johnson was selected to the All-District Second Team; and 20 WHEREAS, the average cumulative grade point average for the Lady Cougars was 91 percent or 3.3 21 on a 4.0-point scale; and 22 WHEREAS, the Lady Cougars' superb 2009-2010 season was a team effort, and the hard work, 23 perseverance, and dedication of the players and the coaching staff, along with the support of the Surry 24 County Board of Supervisors, the Surry County School Board, the Surry community, and Surry County 25 High School students, faculty, staff, and administration paid off in this championship season; now, 26 therefore. be it 27 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring.
