WHEREAS, an enthusiastic teacher, Linda Daniels worked to develop positive learning environmentsand encouraged her students to develop their potential; and

WHEREAS, an energetic and creative woman, Linda Daniels also influenced local children as a
 teacher and director at Great Bridge Presbyterian Church Preschool, where she and her husband are
 members; and

 19 Ministries Women and Family Shelter, and decided to adopt a room, furnishing it with bedding and
 20 other necessities; and

WHEREAS, desirous to be of further service, Linda Daniels created the "Read a Book Leave a
Book" program, where local volunteers bring a book to read to the children at the shelter and then leave
the book so children can read and look at it again; and

WHEREAS, the "Read a Book Leave a Book" program has now grown to 24 women who go once a
week to read and who have left 286 books, creating an easily accessible library for the children of the
shelter so that they can continue to develop their reading skills; and

WHEREAS, Linda Daniels has also dedicated her time and energy to serving the greater community
as an active member of the Chesapeake Friends of the Arts and the Great Bridge Battlefield and
Waterways History Foundation; and
