WHEREAS, Esson McKenzie Miller, Jr., the longtime director of the Division of Legislative 6 7 Services, has announced his retirement in June of 2011; and

WHEREAS, a graduate of Hampton High School, Esson "E.M." Miller earned a bachelor's degree 8 9 from the University of Richmond and a law degree from the University of Tennessee College of Law; 10 and

WHEREAS, E.M. Miller furthered his education throughout his career with studies at the Virginia 11 12 Executive Institute, Harvard Law School, and the Center for Creative Leadership; and

13 WHEREAS, E.M. Miller began his distinguished career working with the legislature as a junior 14 attorney with the Division of Statutory Research and Drafting, the predecessor of the Division of 15 Legislative Services; and

WHEREAS, E.M. Miller's skillful drafting and legal knowledge led to his promotion to senior 16 attorney before he joined the Senate Finance Committee as staff director in 1982, where he oversaw the 17 18 provision of budgetary policy analysis; and

19 WHEREAS, on November 1, 1988, E.M. Miller rejoined the Division of Legislative Services as 20 director, guiding it with great devotion and commitment for the next 23 years; and

WHEREAS, E.M. Miller has worked with great diligence to ensure that the members of the General 21 22 Assembly receive well-written legislation, exemplary research and policy analysis, and other essential 23 services to assist them in fulfilling their duties and obligations; and

24 WHEREAS, a valued member of the Virginia Code Commission, E.M. Miller has shared his 25 extensive legal experience on matters related to the Code of Virginia and administrative regulations and 26 their publication since 1988; and

27 WHEREAS, one of the original members of the Virginia Freedom of Information Advisory Council, 28 E.M. Miller has provided thoughtful insight as the council encouraged and facilitated compliance with 29 the Freedom of Information Act; and

30 WHEREAS, E.M. Miller's contributions to numerous national organizations, including the National 31 Conference of State Legislatures, National Tax Association, and National Conference of Commissioners 32 on Uniform State Laws, have benefitted state legislatures across the country; and

33 WHEREAS, a loyal public servant, E.M. Miller has faithfully provided invaluable service to the 34 legislature and the Commonwealth for almost four decades; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly 35 36 commend Esson McKenzie Miller, Jr., for his distinguished service on the occasion of his retirement; 37 and, be it
