4. Title: Forfeiture of vehicle

5. Summary:

Current law requires that any vehicle knowingly used by its owner, or used by another with his knowledge, during the commission of several specified criminal offenses shall be forfeited to the Commonwealth. The court may authorize the agency seizing the motor vehicle to use it for the investigation of crimes. Otherwise, the motor vehicle is to be sold and the proceeds deposited into the Literary Fund.

The proposed legislation would add any motor vehicle driven while trying to elude law enforcement officers to the list of vehicles to be forfeited.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See Note 8.

8. Fiscal Implications:

The proposed legislation could result in additional revenue for the Literary Fund. Because it is not practicable to project how many additional vehicles would be forfeited under the legislation, nor their value, it is not feasible to project how much additional revenue would be realized.
