Prohibits any person from selling, offering for sale, or displaying for sale pressurized gas dusters in open displays or unlocked cases that are accessible to the public without the intervention of an employee of such business. Violations are a prohibited practice pursuant to the Virginia Consumer Protection Act.

Fiscal Implications: The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' Office of Consumer Affairs is responsible for making inquiries into violations of the Consumer Protection Act and referring cases to the Attorney General or Commonwealth's Attorney for prosecution. Because the Consumer Protection Program has experienced resource reductions, additional responsibilities cannot be assumed without additional support. The Department estimates the need for an additional position to adequately respond to complaints related to violations of this bill. An additional position will cost approximately \$80,000 during the first year and approximately \$65,000 in subsequent years. The estimate includes salary and fringe benefits, information technology charges, and a one-time vehicle expenditure.
