4. Title: School calendar; certain school divisions granted waiver from regular opening schedule.

5. Summary: Adds to the 'good cause' circumstances for which school divisions may be granted a waiver from the post-Labor Day school opening schedule a school division that is entirely surrounded by a school division that has an opening date prior to Labor Day in the school year for which the waiver is sought.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation amends the "good cause" provision for permitting school divisions to begin classes before Labor Day by adding an exception for any school division that is entirely surrounded by school divisions with an opening date prior to Labor Day. It is anticipated this legislation will have no state fiscal impact.
