**4. Title:** Parental notification; school board policy violations.

**5. Summary:** Requires the school principal or his designee to notify the parents of a student who violates a school board policy or the compulsory school attendance requirements when such violation is likely to result in the student's suspension or the filing of a court petition.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation adds language requiring a school principal or his designee to notify the parents of any student that violates a school board policy or compulsory school attendance when the violation is likely to lead to the student's suspension or the filing of a court petition. It is anticipated this legislation could result in additional administrative costs for local school divisions; however, the Department of Education estimates such costs will be nominal and can be absorbed within the current resources. It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact.
