4. Title: Elections; voting procedures and voter identification requirements.

5. Summary: Elections; voting procedures; voter identification requirements. Eliminates the provision that allows a voter to sign a sworn statement that he is the named registered voter he claims to be in lieu of showing identification and requires that any such voter may cast a provisional ballot.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: There is no material fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill should not have a material fiscal impact on State Board of Elections (SBE) in terms of requiring expenditures in addition to those normally associated with legislative implementation.
