## House of Delegates

The House Clerk's Office reported it will have a one-time budget impact of \$4,500 in the first year, which it can absorb. The cost is based on:

\$1,000 Cost to modify the voting system.

\$3,500 Programming cost to prepare the information to give to the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for insertion into the Legislative Information System.

## Senate of Virginia

Senate staff had no response to offer about the fiscal impact at this time.

### <u>Division of Legislative Automated Systems (DLAS)</u>

The director of DLAS reported the bill would have no fiscal impact on his agency. He stated that he would need to do computer programming to recast the information he gets from the two clerks' offices into the form of "voting records" for the Legislative Information System. He would incorporate the programming into his normal workflow so there would be no additional cost.
