3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Conflicts of interests for notaries.

5. Summary: The bill provides that a notary shall not perform any notarial act with respect to any document, writing, or electronic document that presents a conflict between his personal interest and his official duty. A notary who acts in violation of this bill's provision is guilty of official misconduct. Under current law, a notary shall not perform any notarial act with respect to any document, writing, or electronic document to which the notary or his spouse is a party, or in which either of them has a direct beneficial interest, and a notary who performs such act is guilty of official misconduct.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill clarifies and expands existing language, but the Secretary of the Commonwealth's Office confirms that the changes do not present any fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
