4. Title: Fish passageways for the Harvell Dam.

5. Summary: Exempts the Harvell Dam located on the Appomattox River in the City of Petersburg from the requirements of building a fish passageway if the dam obstructs navigation or the passage of fish. However, prior to any breach of the dam, the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries is to prepare a report on the alternatives considered to the proposed breach of the dam. The report is to be submitted to the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources and the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources on or before November 30, 2011.
