3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Voter registration; certain overseas voters.

5. Summary: Changes the duration of a temporary voter registration for certain overseas voters from the end of the federal election cycle or 365 days to the end of the calendar year in which the voter submits the application. The change applies to those voters located overseas and voting absentee in an election due to active duty military service, membership in the merchant marines, employment, or temporary residence outside of the country, or the spouse or dependent residing with such a voter. The change also applies to those voters who reside overseas and were qualified to vote in Virginia prior to leaving the United States or would be qualified but for such overseas residence.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Board of Elections (SBE) does not foresee a significant fiscal impact by the passage of this bill. However, the agency will incur annual training costs for absentee voting, estimated at \$6,300 per year.
