4. Title: A BILL to designate Compton Road in Fairfax County a Virginia byway.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Designates Compton Road in Fairfax County a Virginia byway.

6. Fiscal Impacts are unavailable

8. Fiscal implications: * At a length of approximately 6.5 miles, Compton Road (Route 658), as described in HB 1900 Enr1, does not meet the VDOT/Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) recommended minimum length for designation (10 miles) as a Virginia byway.

* However, if Compton Road is designated as a Virginia byway, VDOT's cost to fabricate and install Virginia Byway designation signage would be dependent on factors such as the number of locations required and the type of installation required.

* VDOT estimates the cost of erecting such signs to be \$850 per sign.
