Summary: Provides for an alcoholic beverage banquet license exception for private meetings or private parties limited in attendance to members of a common interest community and their guests provided (i) the alcoholic beverages shall not be sold or charged for in any way, (ii) the premises where the alcoholic beverages are consumed is limited to the common area regularly occupied and utilized for such private meetings or private parties, and (iii) such meetings or parties are not open to the public.
