4. Title: Law-enforcement employment; disclosure of juvenile records.

5. Summary: Provides that a person who was adjudicated delinquent may be denied employment with the State Police or a local police department or sheriff's office where such denial is based on the nature and gravity of the offense, the time since adjudication, the time since completion of any sentence, and the nature of the job sought. The bill also provides that juvenile record information may be disseminated to the State Police or a local police department or sheriff's office for the purpose of screening a person for employment.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Departments of State Police and Juvenile Justice are not anticipating a fiscal impact due to the legislation.
