**3. Committee:** Courts of Justice

**4. Title:** Establish penalty for installation of an electronic tracking device through deceptive means in or on a motor vehicle

**5. Summary:** This bill creates a Class 3 misdemeanor for any person who installs or places an electronic tracking device in or on a vehicle without the knowledge and consent of the operator. This legislation, which is recommended by the Joint Commission on Technology and Science, does not apply to federal and state law-enforcement officers, judicial officers, probation or parole officers, employees of the Department of Corrections in the lawful performance of their duties, parents or guardians of minors, or owners or lessees of the vehicle.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate (see Section 8)

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Anyone convicted of a Class 3 misdemeanor is subject to a fine up to \$500. There is not enough information available to reliably project the amount of revenue that would be collected from fines as a result of this proposed legislation. However, any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
